

ANTI-SOCIAL BEHAVIOUR

During the past months the village has experienced several episodes of anti-social behaviour resulting in damages of public property at the recreation ground. In specific, damages to the newly installed bins and two of the benches have been broken. Although the benches were old, in the current state they need replacing as they are damaged beyond repair. As for the bins, they had recently been replaced.

More damage was inflicted at the equipment that Westerham Football Club keeps for training purposes. That is twice since they started renting the pitch. The instance was reported to the police, the PCSO will be looking into it.

As Parish Council we aim to take effective and consistent action to tackle anti-social behaviour in all of its forms, and to respond in a way that is reasonable and proportionate to the scale and seriousness of the problem. For this reason the Council is seriously looking into installing CCTV cameras to monitor the activities at the recreation ground. In the meantime, if parishioners have been witnessing suspicious activities at the recreation ground please contact the Parish Clerk and or the PCSO.

ELECTION 2 MAY 2019

Whilst national politics appears to be in a total mess it is currently planned that there will be local elections for District and Parish Councillors on Thursday 2nd May 2019. You will have the opportunity to vote for your Sevenoaks District Councillors – 2 for the Knockholt, Halstead & Badgers Mount ward. There is also an election for Knockholt Parish Council. However this will only occur if there are more than nine candidates. As is normal at the end of a four year term some current Councillors may decide not to seek re-election so a vacancy or vacancies can be expected.



If you are interested in the affairs of your village and would like stand as a candidate or interested in finding out what it would entail please have a word with one of your current Councillors or the Clerk. It is not necessarily an onerous duty, Parish Council meetings are held monthly however you will also get involved in one or two committees that cover the various areas of Council work such as Amenities, Sports & Leisure, Planning, Police, Finance and Publicity – they meet as and when required. There are also other major issues that will have an impact on Knockholt such as the Fort Halstead redevelopment and the future of Broke Hill.

If you are interested in getting involved with your local community a nomination pack is available from the Clerk or from Sevenoaks District Council. The nomination period runs from 26th March until 3rd April. Please don't sit back thinking someone else will do it – Knockholt will need new Councillors after the 2nd May 2019.
