

Meeting of the Sports and Leisure committee held on 18th October 2005 in the Parish Room

1. Declarations of interest

There were none.

2. Terms of Reference

The following were agreed after discussion:

Recommended:

To administer the Recreation Ground and advise the Council on a regular basis of matters related to property and equipment owned by the Council in particular with regard to matters related to public safety.

To discuss, as necessary, matters related to the use of the Recreation Ground facilities with the Council's tenants i.e. the sports clubs.

Recommended:

The children's playground and youth shelter should come under the remit of the Amenities committee.

3. Junior Football Club

A licence fee of £500 was agreed for the junior football club

4. Tennis Club proposal

The tennis club's proposal for floodlights was considered. It was agreed that before further discussion takes place and the terms of an extended lease are proposed the council needs to see the proposed planning application and the club's business plan.

5. Senior Football Club

There was discussion about the ownership of a changing facility. It was agreed that it would be better for it to be owned by the football club but very strong safeguards will need to be put in place for use by other village clubs.

6. Precept 2005/6

An additional £2,500 maintenance + an extra £2,000 as legal fees will be required.
