

Meeting of the Sports and Leisure committee held on 28<sup>th</sup> August 2007

1. Declarations of interest

There were none

2. Land adjacent to the football pitch

A letter responding to the council's enquiry as to the possibility of renting the land adjacent to the football pitch on an annual basis had been received. The committee decided that it was not feasible at the present and were disappointed at the price offered, but may revisit this in the future. The Clerk will reply to Cluttons accordingly.

3. Football pitch drainage.

The use of an 'earthquake machine' has been suggested by Sencio as a good method of improving the drainage of the football pitch. This would cost approximately £300 + VAT. The committee agreed to this as the money is available from its budget.

4. Changing room facilities.

It is understood that the KVCC are drawing up plans for a new village centre. The committee decided to see what is proposed by way of changing facilities before considering the possibility of implementing the extant planning permission. The Clerk will write to the KVCC asking for information as soon as possible as the need for changing rooms is pressing.
