1. Apologies

Apologies were received from Cllr. Crafter

2. Declarations of Interest

There were none.

3. Budget for 2008/9

After discussion a budget of £4,500 was proposed. This would allow for work to fencing around the football pitch to be repaired and for continued drainage work on the football pitch.

4. Letter from Cluttons

Following the latest letter from Cluttons asking what the Council would consider to be a viable rent for the land adjacent to the football pitch it was decided to ask them again about the possibility of purchasing the Recreation Ground prior to any decision re rent..

5. Letter from Cricket Club re licence

The Cricket Club have requested a reduction in the licence fee they pay for use of the pitch.

Proposed: A fee of £400 per year for this current year and next year should be offered.

6. Report back on Open Spaces meeting

Cllr. Broadhurst reported back on the meeting he had attended at SDC about Open Spaces. A 'survey' of open spaces and sports facilities had been done with no reference to Parish Councils The meeting was told that as a result of the dissatisfaction expressed over this there would shortly be liaison with the councils.
